New members discussed practical challenges involving radio-set importation, Radio No-Objection Certificates (NOCs), call-sign allocation and customs clearance. ARSB Vice President Nazrul Islam (S21NZ) explained that the Society has held multiple discussions with the Bangladesh Telecommunication Regulatory Commission (BTRC) on examinations, simplified NOC procedures, call signs and police verification. ARSB will continue policy-level engagement, seeking support from IARU and other relevant bodies when needed.
